

CERTAIN UNCERTAINTY

The basic human desire is to know the world around us, and our fundamental belief is that we can actually do this. In fact, this is the common base of natural sciences. When Newton and his contemporaries laid the foundations of classical physics, it seemed we were quite close to the goal, but as we progressed in time, a very interesting and inevitable rule appeared. When we look at things that are small enough, there are certain properties of which value can only be measured with some inaccuracy. This rule is called the uncertainty principle in physics. Because of this, we cannot quite accurately determine the location of a particle and where it is going. One or the other can be measured with arbitrary accuracy, but never the two together. The laws of nature are simply designed to prevent us from doing so. Nature stubbornly insists on this uncertainty, and this forced inaccuracy had to be

somehow built into physics. This resulted in quantum mechanics. Until then, the position of a particle was given by its 3 coordinates, but from that point on, it has to be replaced by a function that determines how likely that particle is at the specific location. We can still describe the behaviour of things, but now only on a probabilistic basis. So, we can say that from a physics point of view the particle does not really exist until we observe it. It is like being everywhere at once. Then when we observe, we find it somewhere with the probability which is given by the wave function. At first, it seems like nonsense. It is still somehow accepted, that something cannot be accurately measured, but to say that it is not there, or it is everywhere, is quite a wild thought. However, this is currently an accepted scientific fact.



CHAMBOKOLOBY

Since today, Chambok is awash with witches (the day's topic is : Feminism, Witchcraft & Spiritual Activism), we talk to our very own Kata Mersei, who is the closest thing to a (good) witch the Valley has. She has been collecting herbs for months right here, which you can taste at the Tea Shack. She tells it in her own words.

"We have been collecting the herbs since March. That is when the flowering starts. It all begins with nettle. This is a very rich area, we have collected 15 various herbs here in large quantities. This is the first time we have collected herbs for the Tea Shack, altogether 26,5 kilograms of herbs. Whitehorn, el-

derflower, sage, oregano, calendula, thyme (there is a whole field of thyme), lemon grass is grown in the Fairy Garden. It was a huge joy, we collected it, the three of us. It was very exciting to discover this land. This is my life: collecting herbs. This is what I do. This is also a service to humanity. I am very grateful to have been given this opportunity.

Check out the programs of the Herb Hut: today from 6 pm we're doing a thematic garden tour in the Fairy Garden. Friday, it's rolling without tobacco, Saturday: get to know the herbs of Ozora and create colourful teas to take home.



Country: Sweden, UK, Hungary, Norway and Greece

It's a hot day and we are in a rush, we have a deadline here people :) We're walking through the area above Pumpui looking for a camp. Everyone is sleeping or still on the dance-floor. Or again. Then we see some lovely people who have just finished cooking and are starting to eat. I don't want to disturb them but Theresa gives me a smile so I ask them if we can talk. They are in a chilled, good mood and agree. Here is the quick interview that turned out to be 48 minutes of a wonderful talk, where I learned about Thai Box champions and how to measure the universe. Thanks guys, it was sooo lovely!

Tell us about your road trip to O.Z.O.R.A / your O.Z.O.R.A history.

Theresa: We come from Sweden by car so it takes us 2 days to get here. We stay one night in Simontornya and then just hang out in the parking lot. We had perfect timing this year, we ran in and got our spot. We camp here every year, we know the neighbours and everything.

Mike: I came here by accident 10 years ago. I was on a sailing trip in Croatia with my friend and his 14 lawyer friends. This was a really civilized upper class trip. My Australian friend, who owned some bars, said we were going to this psy trance festival in Ozora. This was the first time I had heard this word. But I went anyways. We arrived at 2 in the morning, pitched our little tent in the valley and walked up to the main stage. A German guy was playing this really dark psy trance.

How long does it take to set it up?

Zoltán: 6 hours and 45 minutes, hahaha.
 Mike: 2 days actually. And we also had to rebuild it a little bit because of a design flaw. Zoltán woke up in a little late after the storm. But know it's fixed.

Newest item:

Mike: The solar panel. We have two big batteries that we charge with it. Before we had a generator but it was too noisy and was not environmentally friendly.
 Zoltán: And Pavlos! Hahaaha!

Oldest item:

Mike: Me! And this old tent. It survived all the festivals.
 Zoltán: This amulet. I have it for 9 years. I have it with me all the time.

Most useful item:

Zoltán: The water carrier. It's a big round plastic carrier with a handle. It makes our lives so much easier.

Most beloved item:

Zoltán: The conversations. It's just so interesting. This year we learned a special East London slang from Mike and that the universe is most probably flat.

Theresa: I could come here and be annoyed with the heat, and the noise, and the ants, and all the sh*t, and the neighbours, and this and that. But i'm not. You get what you give. Come prepared and create a home for yourself. This is not just a place to crash for us. It's our home for 10 days.

How do you beat the weather?

Mike: I got this shirt with long sleeves. Light material. It's a life saver against the sun.

Mike: I was surprised about the prices this year.
 Anna: I'm pretty disappointed that they took away the showers at the Main Stage. I loved to dance in the rain! But I know everything is changing all the time!

What is your next destination?

Theresa: I have to get back to my other life. The life outside of O.Z.O.R.A., which seems alien right now. I have a week to "land". I need this time, it's so intense here. You experience so

I had no idea what I was doing there. But I kept coming back when I realized what it's really about.

Zoltán: I also came here by accident. I was this party guy, high on coke all the time and I ended up here with some friends randomly. 10 years ago they started to build the Wheel of Wisdom. I helped build it and there was this challenge to take on a commitment. My commitment was that I wouldn't take any drugs for 5 years. This was in 2010. And I kept my word. In 2015 I came back sober and camped next to these guys and that's how we met. Since then I'm part of the family. O.Z.O.R.A inspired me to live like this all year around. So 4 years ago I moved to Sri Lanka to be able to do it. This festival changed my way of thinking and it is a really important part of my life.

Please introduce your little tribe!

Theresa: Mostly from here. Anna I know from before, she came to my Thai Box club, we trained together and we became friends.

Prettiest item:

Theresa: The little solar lights in front. At night they light up forming a little star. It's really inviting, so we have a lot of visitors.

 Theresa: A big scarf. I can basically use it for everything. I can use it as a dress, put it on my head when it's hot, I sit on it...

 Pavlos: The toilets are a challenge for me.
 Mike: For me the biggest challenge is not to look at my phone. But i'm getting really good at it.
 Zoltán: We know what we are dealing with here. We come prepared.
