**Tell us about your O.Z.O.R.A history.**  
This is my fifth year at O.Z.O.R.A. I came here with a girlfriend and we didn't want to camp only the two of us, so we started to ask around who else was coming. In the end we became this whole big tribe and the whole group fell in love with each other. We became really close friends and we are really important to each other. We also meet during the year, we live close to each other. So this festival gave us friends for life. ## HEALION

### Healing Gets a Permanent Space

*The Healion has moved to a location much better suitable for its purpose, next to the Ambyss and near the Lake, so after many years of dreaming about it, the space for body and soul healing techniques and programs debuted this year with its petal shaped center and bud-like pods dotting the hillside...*

The Ozorian Prophet chats to Vedra, organiser of Healion.

**T.O.P.: So how did you first get involved at O.Z.O.R.A.?**

Vedra: So once we had a festival in my native Croatia, called HanaHana and we also had a small stage where some healers came and I was doing that part also. One day, chief of Magic Garden, Csabi proposed that I do it at Ozora.

**T.O.P.: What got you into healing?**

V: The main reason I like healing is because it's nice to somehow connect with the people and pass on what maybe they don't know and could be for their benefit from physical or emotional point of view. It's real good to be involved in something that can be considered healing. It's not like, yeah, I did it, and patting myself on the back, but you are only there to help the process, and maybe someone opens up to, say, Thai massage because of that.

**T.O.P.: So far it has been difficult, no? Last year, every time it rained, we heard on the radio: Healion is closed off and we saw you, walking around like a madwoman. Has it been a difficult journey?**

V: With the place, it was a long time, this transition (sighs). We were here, there and everywhere, in lots of places at O, trying to present these healing techniques and trying to bring many practitioners. Now, after 7 years we finally have a real venue. Healion evolved into a place that can accommodate even more people, even more workshops and lectures. It's a permanent structure, nice looking, and good to work inside.

**T.O.P.: Were you involved in the design?**

V: Yes, my friends did the construction, before which we had just been brainstorming. First it was: what is needed, and then to have a freaking cool structure. To melt it together. It also needed to be sound and waterproof and yeah, beautiful.

**T.O.P.: Did the new place influence the programme already?**

V: Yes, but mainly because the treatment pods are on a higher level, so we are not affected by rain. Come on, we don't get washed away, for f.ck's sake!

**T.O.P.: Are there any new practices this year?**

V: No. We tend to have many techniques, as many as possible. Energy work, or 200 ppl trance dance workshops. The aim is to have different things that you can find your place in, and therapists, and to bring it...we try to widen it, and bring more, new techniques. Now comes the development part. This what we have is a sound base, and I would like to widen it - both in scope (what we have to offer), and also in space, expanding Healion.
