Today the land gives home to 5 stages (all of them with a specific vibe and dazzling visuals), an immense art exhibition tower and countless art-related workshops, a pyramid for movement-based activities, a house for lectures and talks, a circus, a fire show space, a bio garden, a community kitchen with free tea all day-long, children's playground with many daily programs, a pavilion for healing activities and many-many organically developing nooks filled with enchanted land art pieces and visual messages.

It is an experience that can form how one looks at human community, society and the value of self-expression in creation. Our goal is to connect people with acceptance, curiosity and respect, to emerge together from under our man-created limitations. We work all year long on strengthening the bonds and make new ones by bringing the Ozorian Vibe to distant countries through events, the radiOzora broadcast and the Ozorian Prophet magazine.

Loving is believing, and we love the idea that stepping out of the existing social structure can help us better understand ourselves, the errors of modern urban lifestyle and bring us closer to our inner values and our growing global tribe.

'All-purpose wear for the twisted mind.' We have admired and worn the creative, unique fashion art of the scene's two influential workshops, namely the Plazmalab family and Indian Project, for decades, much long before we could find their shops in various points of the world and the market areas of all the significant gatherings. The two original, individual workshops have most recently fused together in an expressive shop, in power and spirit, a great example of how some dreams can come true here locally. These

friends, with 'not little' experience around world, have brought together not only their high-quality and unique fashion sense, but also the people who find Goa the place to realize a

But, as some of you may know, Plazma Lab is truly a diverse art collective, and we can see signs of their artistic collaborations all around the festival grounds too.


For a monumental eve-catcher, you can admire the huge colorful mural on the house of lectures, the Chambok, that Ross Plazma of the Lab co-created 2 years ago. And if we're talking about monumental, in 2018 we could see the artistic result of an Israeli-Hungarian collaboration, namely between Ross and 'scrap metal artist', Csilla Berkes, who's metal dragon guards the Ozorian market road bridge. The sculpture-creature-installation, called Shed (yes, to mean 'demon'), the two artists created was meant to be a kind of floating fountain in the middle of the pond, but last minute environmental protection issues changed the plans, and it eventually ended up living by the side of the Lake. So, this huge installation, steampunked into a nautically inspired hybrid creature, landmarks the Ozorian beach instead, a perfect example of the Ozorian spirit of fusing talents to bring to life something unique and truly inspired.

The Ozorian stages have starred Israeli artists since the dawn of our festival, and throughout the years some of the most loved actors of our wing-spreading scene have come from the 'Promised Land', always delivering on their promise of putting on unforgettable shows, raising dust on dancefloors, becoming like family in the meantime. What's more, the Israeli legendary labels, collaborations and psytrance trends also play key roles in shaping the music that makes our reality. This year we are looking forward to yet another full-blast edition with some of 'the best of the best' DJs and producers who hail from Israel.

The Main Stage won't be missing two internationally famed 'heavyweights', ACE VENTURA and ASTRIX of course, and we can also experience some big-banging psytrance through the union of their musical minds, as ALPHA PORTAL, And as for another exciting collaboration, and time travel back to the future, this summer Yoni Oshrat and DJ Goblin are arousing the dancefloor with PSYSEX. Psy-pirate

CAPTAIN HOOK is also returning this year, pumping some trance back into psytrance to explore new 'Origin's. There's going to be some serious 'Future Music'. to say the least, when **HUJABOY & STRIDERS** cuts edges with their seamless, bold production, and we get a proper psy-'Stimulation' with SKIZOLOGIC. You can also expect a (HOM)mega show from MODUS, who will be wreaking some dancefloor havoc and might even cause a little 'Organic Panic'. And we're excited about another well-fused duo as well, Lennon-inspired Martian, Imagine Mars aka DJ Osh, and half of Vertical Mode, Volcano, bringing us the sensibility of 'Sacred Technology' and eruptions of VOLCANO ON MARS.

Meanwhile at Pumpui there is some genre-skipping and new sound invention with psychilled DJ Bayawaka serving the crowd a GOLANSKI special, and label head of Disco Halal and Treisar, MOSCOMAN bringing his imaginative new waves of techtrancey soundscapes to the Ozorian audience.

BODY MIND SOUL

DO YOU NEED A BRIDGE?



"If you already are where you need to be, do you need a bridge? If there is nowhere to go, do you need a bridge? Have there been little bridges built across your synaptic gaps to make things faster? When we see the word "bridge" or think about bridges over which we have traveled or even card games we have played, images may spring to mind in the form of pictures or sounds or sensations in the bodymind. Now, of course, when that happens you all know what to do. Any moment of experience that arises which you know of which there is a moment of knowing - is the opportunity presenting itself freely and for no reason whatsoever, it is presenting itself for you to practise or for Knowing, which is what you really are, to practise that moment of noticing. And it's so simple! Feel the breath moving the arches of the ribs in and out. Feel the architecture

of the bones and allow the bodymind to align and straighten itself. Feel the neck straighten and balance the skull. Open to peripheral vision and you have practised that moment. As vou do that over and over and over again, practice becomes embodied. That means that many, indeed all, - over time - all the patterns that have been set in place in the bodymind are opened and you find that you are where you always were, which is in this moment and you have everything you need to Wake Up entirely, to Wake Up past all of your beliefs and stories about who you are and how the world is so that the bodymind is living the experience of this moment and you know that that is what you are doing. You know that this moment is being responded to skillfully in appropriate ways."
