The space will be much tighter since we share the garden, but it will also change the vibe because it's a family/kids area I'm not vet sure how that will turn out, but I'm confident it will be an interesting experiment

How has the new location influenced the programming for this year? Does it allow for different types of rograms, or has it taken away space from certain Ambyss concepts?

I tailored it to a more world/good vibe/chill/ambient music, less dark since our programming is mainly during the daytime The family camp and kids area definitely made the lineup easier to arrange, musically speaking. We have the Cosmic Theatre, so there will be a lot more playfulness in the air, which will balance well with the relaxed waves of music.

Your personal highlights of Ambyss this year.

I never really have highlights since everything is equally exciting, but of course, live actions always bring more excitement to the human body than a good DJ set (though both are balanced and enjoyable). So, just stick around and listen to the various sounds. We have solo performances, electronic acts, instrumental concerts, morning ragas, and unpredictable dance sets. My heart is beating so fast just thinking about it that I have to stop typing. Loves!
